SKAGWAY

Skagway is a compact city in southeast Alaska, set along the popular cruise route the Inside Passage. Its home to gold-rush era buildings now preserved as part of the Klondike Gold Rush National Historical Park. Take an excursion on the White Pass & Yukon Route Railroad, which runs vintage locomotives past the famously steep Chilkoot trail and offers sweeping mountain views during its climb toward Canada.
